VLSP has two different programs available to Yates County residents:

- Help Centers
 - These centers are located in the Rochester Hall of Justice or the Rochester Central Library
 - Provides free legal and procedural information
- Family Law Remote Assistance Project
 - Connects unrepresented litigants with VLSP volunteer attorneys (volunteers are attorneys from Rochester). Attorneys are ready to assist in completing Family Court Petitions
 - Services provided via webcam in partnership with the family's local Library
