## **Presentation: Equal Justice Program**

**Rebecca Smith** – *also see power point and brochure attached for more information*

- Program is through Law NY
- Focuses on employment and re-entry issues for individuals with a criminal background
- Can review and make corrections to criminal records and RAP sheets, most errors are usually clerical
- Prepares individuals through mock interviews on how to answer questions about their criminal background
- Educates individuals on their employment rights and laws that protect them
- The only things that can affect employment opportunities is when there is a direct relationship between crime and potential job, or when there is an unreasonable risk to property or person based on criminal background
- Assists with obtaining proper licensure like gaming licenses to work at a casino or CNA licenses
- Also assists individuals with unemployment issues, discrimination, civil services law, CPS indicted reports, DMV license questions if related to employment, etc.
- There are a couple bilingual staff members and an interpreter phone services
