Child Care Aware® employs 1 part time and contracts with 1 Registered Nurses who provide health consultancy services that support child care providers throughout Steuben and Schuyler Counties. The services provided include, but are not limited to;

- Facilitation of the Medication Administration Training,
- Assisting providers and programs in complying with regulations pertaining to the health care plan requirements for the administration of medications,
- Providing trainings which enhance the professionalism of each provider's program,
- Acting as a resource person for questions regarding the growth and development of infants and toddlers and for the care of mildly-ill-children.
