- Provides medical, dental care and an integrated medical /behavioral health model to address all aspects of the patient needs.
- In dental they offer, and encourage, a full care approach to help clients maintain continual care rather than waiting until there is an emergency situation.
- RPCN will assist patients with payment through a discounted rate or sliding fee scale and applying for insurance.
- RPCN has a Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner and Counselor.
- Their goal is to reduce stigma of mental health and promote behavioral health thru ongoing counseling and follow through with medications and connecting patients with appropriate mental/behavioral health resources.
- Support patients with referral to outside care management if appropriate.
- May help with needs such as homelessness, lack of food, etc.
- Can work with patients if they are open to assistance.
