**Updates:**

DSS

- HEAP Cooling Program has started. If a family is already receiving HEAP they do not need to fill out the entire application. To qualify they need to have a medical note from their doctor stating why they need an air conditioner. Applications are available at DSS.

FLACRA

- Agency has emergency services available for addicts or family members in crisis.
- The Independent Housing program has a long waiting list. Flip, another housing program that is available offers assistance for rent, security deposit, gas/electric to help prevent eviction. There is a \$500 limit/family.
