The Home Visitor position requires the minimum of a home-based CDA credential or equivalent coursework as part of an Associate's or Bachelor's degree. Excellent organizational/time management skills and flexibility are requirements of this position. A driver's license meeting agency standards and consistent, reliable transportation are required.

Responsibilities of the Home Visitor include recruiting and enrolling eligible children and families, providing educational activities for pregnant women, infants, toddlers and preschool age children in a home setting, supporting family engagement in their child's development, and supporting families in a goal setting process and accessing additional resources.
