Pro Action Child Care Council (PACCC) ensures that all modalities of child care programs have access to services that promote a strong healthy environment. PACCC employs a Registered Nurse who provide health consultancy services that support child care providers throughout Steuben and Schuyler Counties. The services provided include, but are not limited to;

- Assisting providers and programs in complying with regulations pertaining to the health care plan requirements for the administration of medications,
- Providing trainings which enhance the professionalism of each provider's program,
- Acting as a resource person for questions regarding the growth and development of infants and toddlers and for the care of mildly-ill-children.

Basic Technical Assistance: assistance lasting less than one hour that is handled by phone, e-mail, or in-person at Pro Action building in Bath. Also includes, assistance writing a non-MAT Health Care Plan, Individual Health Care Plan for a child with special health care needs, medication error support, questions concerning medication administration regulations, "best practices", communicable diseases and other matters related to the health of children.	- All modalities - Hours vary depending on scheduled days in office and out in field.	Funded by CCR&R contract. No cost to provider.
Health Care Consultant(HCC) of Record	- All modalities who are MAT approved or center programs that care for Infants and Toddlers. - Two-year contracts	DCC & SACC: \$110 Yearly Contract to be HCC of Record. GFDC: \$50 Yearly Contract to be HCC of Record. FDC: \$50 Yearly Contract to be HCC of Record. Development, initial visit, review and sign off of HCP are included as part of the CCR&R services when you contract to have a HCC of Record.
Intensive Technical Assistance (ITA) is offered at program site and lasts a minimum of one hour.	All Modalities, non-MAT addressing medical questions and accommodations.	Funding may be available through CCR&R contract.
